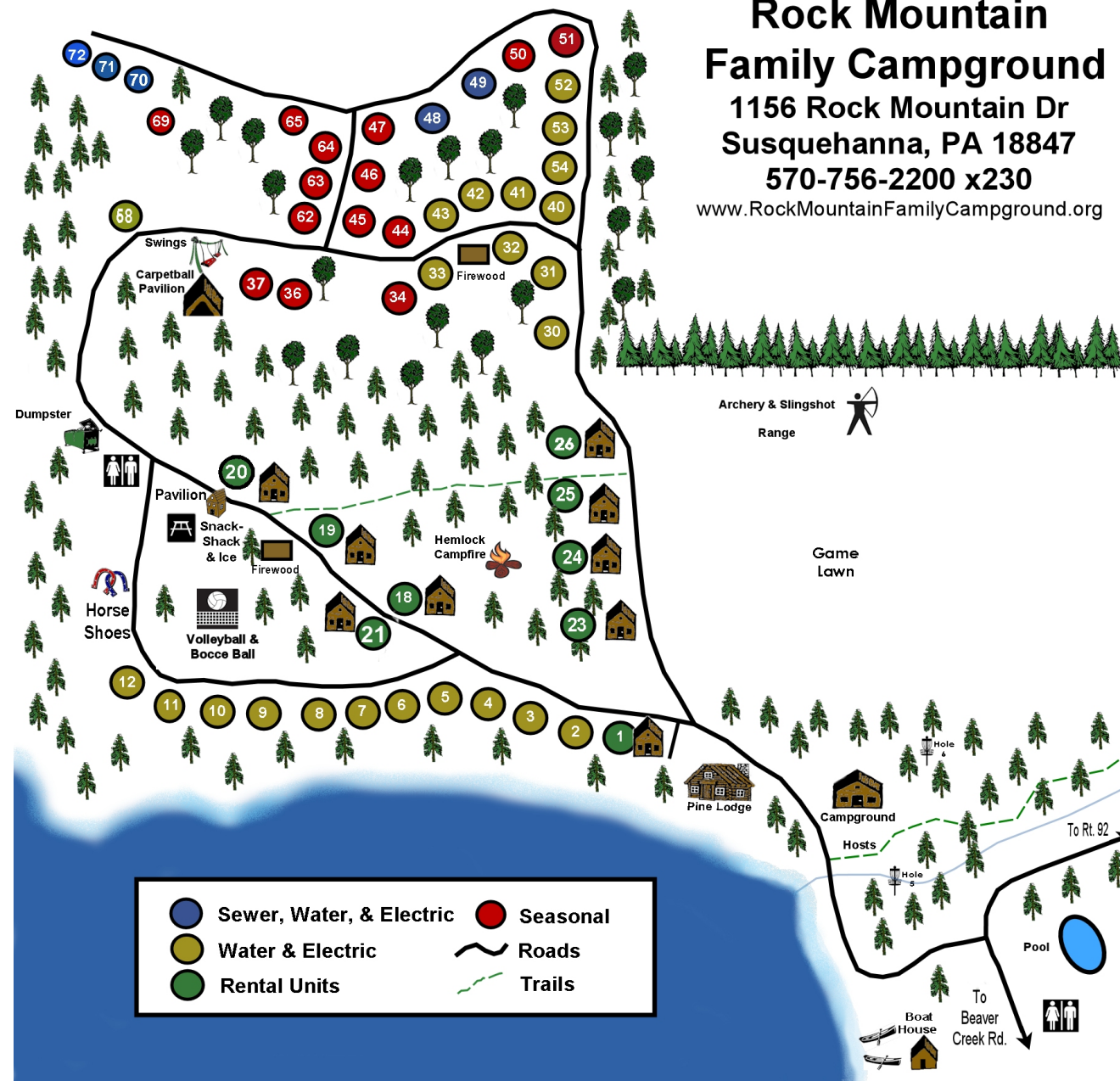

Campground Rates

Camp Site, water & electric	\$30.00
Camp Site, water, electric & sewer	\$35.00
Cottage (Rental Unit 1)	\$90.00
Camping Cabin (Rental Units 18-26)	\$60.00
Day Guest (individual)	\$5.00
Day Guest (family)	\$15.00

Rates are per night. Site occupancy is 1 **immediate** family per site OR 5 individuals per site. Cottage and Camping Cabins allowed up to 5 individuals. Occasionally doubling-up is permitted on selected sites and requires a second campsite fee. Youth and other groups should call for per person rates. Unmarried campground guests must stay in separate rental units, or on separate sites from guests of the opposite gender.

RMBC Do's and Don'ts...

Thank you for following these rules and all other posted regulations for the enjoyment of all at RMBC Family Campground!

Check-in is **2:00pm** for all sites and units.

Check-out is **11:00am** for rental units;
12:00pm for campsites.

All 'Main Camp' buildings including Main Building, Gym, and other buildings are not available to campground guests.

Campfires must be contained within the provided fire ring; **do not move fire rings**. Campfires are subject to restrictions ordered by local authorities.

Fishing is **CATCH AND RELEASE ONLY**. A valid PA fishing license is required for individuals 16 years and older.

Boating Equipment is shared—please return boats promptly to boathouse after each use, and properly store equipment after use. NEVER DOCK CAMP BOATS AT CAMPSITES!

Boaters 12 and under must wear a lifejacket, all others must have a lifejacket with them in the boat. No boating after dark.

Pool is open according to posted hours. ADULT SUPERVISION IS REQUIRED FOR YOUTH 12 AND UNDER! No swimming after dark, or alone. **The pool is open Memorial Day Weekend until Labor Day.**

Swimwear must be modest with no bare midriffs and swim pants are mandatory for infants and toddlers.

Pets are NOT ALLOWED in the cottage, cabin units, or pool area. Pets must be leashed and supervised at all times, have current vaccinations and licenses and be cleaned up after. RMFC reserves the right to determine when barking, troublesome pets must be removed.

Visitors must report to the campground hosts and pay the day-use fee. Visitors must abide by all campground guidelines. Overnight guests must be approved prior to visit.

Prohibited items and actions include illegal drugs, alcohol, fireworks, firearms or other weapons, removing branches from live trees, picking flowers, gathering plants, cutting firewood, hunting, feeding or disturbing wildlife, use of unlicensed motorized vehicles. While not encouraged, smoking is only allowed on your campsite.

Quiet Hours are 10pm to 8am. Please be considerate of other guests. Children under 16 are to be under parent's direct supervision throughout quiet hours.

Frequently Asked Questions:

How can we make reservations?

When can I make reservations for next year?

Reservations can be made **November 2nd** online, or by phone. (Organized Church or Family Groups can make reservations October 14, by phone).

How do I get a seasonal site?

Contact the Program Manager to arrange a Seasonal Site, or to be placed on a waiting list.

What is an Extended Stay site?

An Extended Stay Site is a designated site which is rented from June 1, until August 31. To reserve a site contact Program Manager.

While every attempt will be made to minimize negative impacts to your experience, we appreciate your patience with any extra noise or facility-use restrictions related to Main-Camp campers/guests.

RMBC Campground Information

Activity Areas include the hiking/biking trails, lake/boats, pool, outdoor courts (basketball, gaga ball, tetherball, swings), geocaching, disc golf course, and bouldering wall are shared with the Main Camp. The playground and carpetball pavilion, GaGa Pit, Pine Lodge, volleyball court, bocce ball, and the horseshoe area are all available to campground guests. Disc Golf Course Maps, and discs can be signed out with campground hosts.

Facilitated activities including archery, sling-shots, hayrides, lasertag*, ropes course*, & zipline* are available by-request, or as scheduled. Contact the Program Manager for availability.

**Activities fees required.*

Trash must not be left unattended on campsites. A dumpster is located adjacent to the campground bathhouse.

Food must not be left unattended on campsites. Coolers and food must be secured at all times.

Firewood is for sale per crate at campground woodsheds. Please return crate & wagon to the woodshed promptly

Snack shack is open as scheduled.

Ice is available for purchase from Snack Shack porch.

Emergency Procedures are posted on bulletin boards by the restrooms.
