# RMBC Do's and Don'ts...

Thank you for following these rules and all other posted regulations for the enjoyment of all at Rock Mountain.

**Check-in** is 2:00pm.

**Check-out** is 11:00am.

**Camp buildings** including Main Building, Gym, and other buildings are only available as arranged with the camp office.

**Campfires** must be contained within the designated fire pits. Campfires are subject to restrictions ordered by local authorities.

**Fishing** is **CATCH AND RELEASE ONLY**. A valid PA fishing license is required for individuals 16 years and older.

**Boats** are available while lake is not frozen. No boating after dark.

**Boating Equipment** is shared—please return boats promptly to boathouse after each use, and properly store equipment after use.

**PFDs**— ALL boaters MUST wear a PFD (life-jacket), from November 1– April 30.

**Pets are NOT ALLOWED.**

**Visitors** must register with the Camp Office and pay the day-use fee. Visitors must abide by all Lodge Guest guidelines.

**Emergency Procedures** are posted inside each Lodge.

**Please keep valuables** locked in your vehicle, RMBC is not responsible for loss, damage, or theft.

**Prohibited items and actions** include illegal drugs, alcohol, smoking/vaping, fireworks, firearms or other weapons, removing branches from live trees, picking flowers, gathering plants, cutting firewood, hunting, feeding or disturbing wildlife, use of unlicensed motorized vehicles.

**Quiet Hours** are 11pm to 8am. Please be considerate of other guests. Children under 16 are to be under parent's direct supervision throughout quiet hours.
