

What to Bring to Junior Day Camp...

Jr Day Campers will have a designated place to store their gear and to change. The program is an active schedule and is outside the majority of the time, we have been known to play in the rain sometimes (when safe to do so). Pack appropriate clothing for each day and make sure to pack rain gear.

- Modest Bathing Suit (no bare midriffs) & Towel
- Comb/Brush
- Sunscreen
- Sneakers & Socks for Games, and/or Sandals for the Pool
- Extra Socks & Change of Clothes
- 1 Raincoat/ poncho
- Sweatshirt or Fleece (weather-dependent)
- 1 Large Plastic Garbage Bag (Laundry/Wet Swimsuit)
- 1 Bible
- Fishing Pole / Tackle (optional)

Snack Shack Bank:

There is a debit system for campers at the Snack Shack. Money will be turned in at Check-in (Monday morning for Jr Day Campers). Campers give their name to the Snack Shack staff when buying snacks, who will deduct that amount each day from their account. Remaining \$ will be returned to the parent/guardian at check-out.

Media & Technology Use @ Camp:

Junior campers are NOT allowed keep cell phones, media players, or other electronic games in their possession during the week of camp. If parents would like their child to call home during the week, they can check-in a cell phone at Check-in on Sunday. The camper can then check-out the phone to call home during their afternoon free time (2:15-4pm). The Program Manager has the authority to deny this privilege for the duration of the program if the use of a cell phone goes against camp standards or policies.

WiFi access is NOT available to campers.

Any media players or electronic devices in a campers' possession will be confiscated for the duration of the program and returned to a parent/guardian at check-out.
