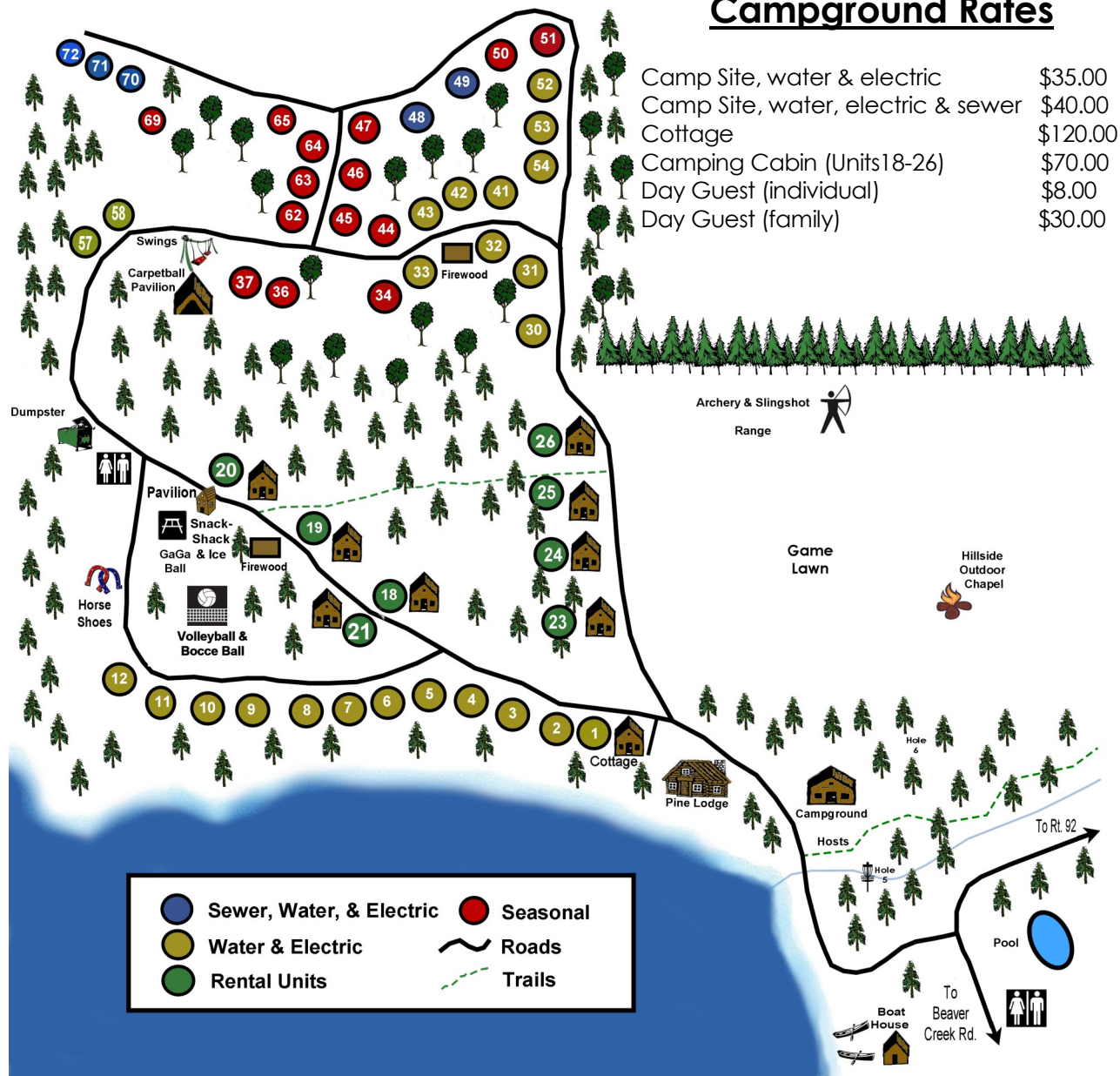
Dear Camper,

***Rates are per night. Site occupancy is 1 immediate family per site, OR 5 individuals per site. Occasionally doubling-up is permitted on selected sites and requires a second campsite fee, or paying per-person. Long term site options include Extended Stays (June 1-August 31) or Monthly Stays (30-day minimum).

RMBC DO'S AND DON'TS...

THANKS FOR FOLLOWING THESE RULES AND POSTED POLICIES FOR THE ENJOYMENT OF ALL AT THE FAMILY CAMPGROUND!

Check-in is **3:00pm** for all sites and units.

Check-out is **12:00m** for all sites and units.

Quiet Hours are 11pm to 8am. Please be considerate of other guests. Children under 16 are to be under parent's direct supervision throughout quiet hours.

PETS ARE NOT ALLOWED IN THE COTTAGE,

CABINS OR POOL AREA. Pets must be leashed and supervised at all times, have current vaccinations and licenses and be cleaned up after. RMBC reserves the right to ask pets to be removed

Visitors must report to the campground hosts and pay the day-use fee. Visitors must abide by all campground guidelines.

Prohibited items and actions include illegal drugs, alcohol, fireworks, firearms or other weapons, removing branches from live trees, picking flowers, gathering plants, cutting firewood, hunting, feeding or disturbing wildlife, use of unlicensed motorized vehicles. While not encouraged, smoking is only permitted on your campsite (not in rental units/porches).

Main Camp' buildings including Main Building, Gym, and other structures are not available to campground guests without authorization. Facility rental fees may apply.

Campfires must be contained within the provided fire ring; **do not move fire rings.** Subject to local authorities & burn bans.

Fishing is **CATCH AND RELEASE ONLY.** A valid PA fishing license is required for individuals 16 years and older.

Boating Equipment is shared—please return boats promptly to boathouse after each use, and properly store equipment after use. NEVER DOCK CAMP BOATS AT CAMPSITES!

Boaters 12 and under must wear a lifejacket, all others must have a lifejacket with them in the boat. No boating after dark.

Pool is open according to posted hours. ADULT SUPERVISION IS REQUIRED FOR YOUTH 12 AND UNDER! No swimming after dark, or alone. The pool is open Memorial Day Weekend until Labor Day.

Swimwear must be modest with no bare midriffs. Swim pants are mandatory for infants and toddlers.

All Campground campers are expected to abide by our standards of behavior/practice that align with our beliefs on biblical sexuality. Families may stay in single units, single-gender lodging is expected for non-related guests (Men and Women in separate lodgings), public displays of affection must be appropriate and align with our beliefs on biblical sexuality and restrooms are to be used according to biological sex. For more details regarding our beliefs on biblical sexuality, please contact our Program Manager or Camp Director.

Reservation & Site Information

Reservations for 2026 open Nov 1st. Organized groups can make reservations beginning Oct 22.

Seasonal Sites can be requested with the Program Manager. If no sites are available, you will be placed on a waiting list and be notified when a site becomes available.

RMBC CAMPGROUND INFORMATION

Activity Areas include the hiking/biking trails, lake/boats, pool, outdoor courts (basketball, gaga ball), geocaching, disc golf course, and bouldering wall are shared with the Main Camp. The playground and carpetball pavilion, gaga pit, Pine Lodge, volleyball court, and bocce ball are all available to campground guests. Disc Golf Course Maps, and discs can be signed out with campground hosts.

Facilitated activities including archery, sling-shots, hayrides, lasertag*, ropes course*, & zipline* are available by-request, or as scheduled. Contact the Program Manager for availability.

**Activity fees required.*

Trash must be not be left unattended on campsites. A dumpster is located adjacent to the campground bathhouse.

Food must not be left unattended on campsites. Coolers and food must be secured at all times.

Firewood is for sale per crate at campground woodsheds. Please return crate & wagon to the woodshed promptly

Snack shack is open as scheduled.

Ice is available for purchase from Snack Shack.

Emergency Procedures are posted on bulletin boards by the restrooms.
