

STAFF PACKING GUIDE

The purpose of this guide is to help you make decisions in packing for when you are serving at RMBC. Listed are items you will **NEED** to bring, items that you are **ALLOWED** to bring if you desire, and things you should **NOT** bring to camp. WHAT TO BRING - STUFF YOU WILL NEED

- Alarm Clock & Watch
- T-shirts / Shirts (*And a staff shirt or two if you have one!)
- Jeans / Pants
- Shorts (at least mid-thigh length & modest)
- Hat, Bandana or other head covering (for serving in the kitchen/dining room)
- Undergarments
- Sweatshirt / Fleece / Sweater (a warm layer)
- Coat &/or Rain Coat (a waterproof layer)
- Footwear Close-toed shoes/sneakers, boots, & sandals
- Bathing Suit (Guys-mid-thigh length, Girls no bikinis, bare midriffs, high cut legs, low-cut front)
- Personal Toiletries (whatever keeps you smellin' good & lookin' pretty!)
- Bible, Notebook, Pen/Pencil
- Flashlight
- Water Bottle
- Personal Medication
- Laundry Soap (if you plan to do laundry at camp)
- Sheets/Sleeping Bag & Pillow
- Towels-For Showers & the Pool

WHAT TO BRING - STUFF YOU MAY WANT

- Bike, skateboard, roller blades, scooter Un-motorized Only.
- Personal Snacks / Drinks store in your housing unit.
- Bluetooth Speaker- only music that edifies.
- Laptop Computer / Tablet- watching TV shows &/or movies is not allowed, unless on day off.
- Cell Phone cannot use during work hours or after lights-out (voice/text/data).
- Personal Recreation Gear fishing pole & tackle, sports equipment, hammock etc.
- Musical Instruments
- Personal Comfort Items- Bug Spray, Box or Oscillating Fan, Sun-screen, etc.

WHAT NOT TO BRING-STUFF YOU SHOULDN'T HAVE AT CAMP!

- Firearms (BB guns, rifles, shotguns, handguns, grenade launchers, etc.)
- Fireworks (firecrackers, bottle rockets, mortars, etc.)
- Controlled Substances (Alcohol, tobacco products, illegal drugs, drug paraphernalia, etc.)
- Motorized Recreational Vehicles (ATVs, motorcycles, snowmobiles, motorboats, etc.)
- TVs/Projectors (see note about laptops/tablets).
- Clothing with potentially offensive slogans or topics depicted on them.
- Clothing that is tight fitting, immodest, &/or exposes undergarments.
 - "If it's TIGHT, SHORT, or REVEALING . . . don't wear it at camp."
