All staff will receive a stipend for their personal expenses while at camp. We understand that even with a stipend, it is a financial sacrifice to serve at camp. Stipends differ according to age due to typical differences in personal expenses. Stipends also differ for certain positions/roles due to higher levels of responsibility and leadership.
